- Header/context for visit
 - Problem List
 - Active
 - Inactive (pmhx/psurghx)
 - CC/HPI/ROS (interim hx)
 - Fam/Soc Hx
 - Med Allergy (structured)
 - Updated Med List (structured)
 - Physical Exam (free text box 2)
 - Data (free text box 3)
 - Assessment/Plan (free text box 4)
 - Health Maintenance
(HM free text box 5 w common tests.
Use EZVax to record vaccines, don't free text as others on campus can't find it)
- free text box 1
1. Problem list must be "weeded" frequently
 - Keep active and inactive together so easier for shuffling
 2. Structure Meds List reconciled and updated at every visit
 - Bottle checks is safest
 - Don't be afraid to clean up list, no need for your own list
 3. Data- don't hoard or mass paste, list important values recent
 4. Assessment at each visit
 - One line summary
 - problem not organ list
 5. Health Maintenance- pt centered
 6. RTC interval
